## **Carl Frazier Retires From ICTC**

Tom Stiles, Superintendent of Indian Capital Technology Center, announced the retirement of Carl Frazier, Business Manager, in December 2008.

Frazier is a graduate of Wainwright High School, Wainwright, Oklahoma. He graduated from Oklahoma State University, Okmulgee in 1966. He worked for Phillips 66 Oil Company in Bartlesville for two years, before serving two years in the U. S. Army. When he returned from the service, he worked another two years at Phillips before accepting his current position at Indian Capital in 1973.

Frazier has worked at Indian Capital Technology Center for 35 years. He has served as Business Manager under all, but one, Board member whose term ended in 1972. He has served under all but one Superintendent, Dr. Karl Doss (1968-1970), deceased.

Frazier is a member of the Chandler Road Church of Christ. He served on the Hilldale School District Board of Education for ten years. He and his wife, Rhonda, have been married for 44 years. They have two children, Carla and Robbie. They reside in Muskogee.
